TECK TIP

Deco Art Traditions Paint many of us have changed to Traditions paint as recommended by Pat Godin. This paint arrives sometime thick and somewhat dry. If you add "demineralized water" to thin and a ¼ + ball bearing or stainless-steel nut to act as a mixing ball, shake well and the paint is much easier to handle.


