

# MALLARD BUST



### This class is designed for new carvers.

Diane will walk the new carver through the various stages of carving from selecting the best wood to which tools to use including Fordoms, micro motors, burners and painting as well as the various techniques for all of the skills required for wildlife carving. Diane has taken several classes with World class instructors, and is an accomplished open level carver. This class is designed for small numbers and lots of one on one training.

**REQUIRED TOOLS:** STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO BRING A POWER GRINDER I.E. fordom or a dremel with a flex shaft, some coarse bits and some fine bits. A sharp carving knife, a pr. of calipers, a flexible ruler or straight edge, a mechanical pencil, an assortment of paint brushes #1,2,3. Dust masks and safety glasses are recommended. Some tool can be rented from the AWCA for new carvers not sure where to start.

In conversation with a couple of you a few days ago it was suggested that we might restart carving at Northgate Lions earlier in the fall than originally planned.
